Ring 1 Entries £7 Commencing 9.30am prompt

Unaffiliated Open Show Jumping. *Open to horses and ponies with riders of any age,*
Class 1 **Pre Novice Jumping** - 2'3" *approx in first round (combination not to have won a 1st at this height or above)*

Class 2 **Novice Jumping** - 2'6" *approx in first round*

Class 3 **Intermediate Jumping** - 2'9" *approx in first round*

Class 4 **Open Jumping** - 3' *approx in first round*

Class 5 **Open Jumping** - 3'3" *approx in first round*

Ring 2 Entries £7 Commencing 9.30am prompt

JUDGE **Mr S Hart (Classes 6 – 9 & Championship)**

Judge may wish to ride.

Class 6 **Working Hunter Pony** – *not exceeding 15hh, riders not to have attained 18th birthday by 1st January 2008.*

Class 7 **Novice Working Hunter** - 2'6" *approx. For horses 15hh & over*

Class 8 **Small Working Hunter** – 2'9" *approx. Exceeding 14.2hh but not exceeding 15.2hh*

Class 9 **Open Working Hunter** – 3' *approx, Exceeding 15hh.*

Championship **Classes 6,7,8 & 9 – winner & second in each class.**

JUDGE **Miss A Gibbons (Classes 10 – 14 & Championship)**

Judge may wish to ride.

Class 10 **Novice Ridden Show Hunter.** *Exceeding 15hh. Not to have won a Ridden Show Hunter Class.*

Class 11 **Open Ridden Show Hunter.** *Exceeding 15hh*

Class 12 **Riding Horse.** *Exceeding 14.2hh. To be judged on manners, confirmation and turnout.*

Class 13 **Ridden Coloured.** *Horses and ponies any height, to be judged on manners, confirmation and turnout.*

Class 14 **Ex Racehorse.** *Must be registered with Weatherbys, please show passport to secretary, Judged on confirmation, manners and turnout and short freestyle show to include a small jump.*

Championship **Classes 10,11,12,13&14 winner & second in each class.**

Class 15 **Best Turned Out.** *Not judged on confirmation.*

Class 16 **Leading Rein Pony.** *Pony not to exceed 12.2hh riders not to have attained 8th birthday by 1st January 2008*

Class 17 **Best Pony Club Pony.** *Not exceeding 14.2hh, riders not to attained 16th birthday by 1st January 2009. Judged on suitability, manners, turnout and a short freestyle show to include a small jump*

Class 18 **Open Ridden Mountain and Moorland.** *To be split small & large breeds if entries warrant.*

Class 19 **Best cared for veteran (ridden) 15 years and over.** *To be ridden and judged on condition, wellbeing and turnout*

Class 20 Best cared for veteran (in Hand) 15 years and over. *To be judged on condition, wellbeing and turnout.*

Classes 19 & 20 are qualifiers for VHPRC (www.vhprc.com)

Championship Classes 15,16,17,18,19&20 winner & second in each class.

Class 22 Lead Rein – 1'6" approx, riders 10 years and under.

Class 23 Assisted Jumping - 1'9" approx, riders 10 years and under

Class 24 Novice Jumping – 2' approx

Class 25 Novice Jumping – 2'3" approx

Class 26 Novice Jumping – 2'6" approx

Gymkhana

Will not start before 2pm all entries at ringside £1.50 per race / £6 per class

Classes A – B lead rein or assisted *ONLY*, **Classes C – E** Off Lead rein

Classes include Potato Race, Ride & Run, Musical Sacks, Monte Carlo, Sweet Race.

1. Open to horses & ponies 4 years & over. Rider any age *unless* stated otherwise.
2. The Judge's decision is final
3. Any objections must be handed to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident together with a deposit of £10.
4. Hard hats and suitable footwear must be worn at all times when mounted. Chin straps must be fastened when mounted.
5. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, amend or re-arrange the order of events, to refuse entry without stating a reason and to disqualify any animals which in their opinion are unfit to compete.
6. The organisers reserve the right to send from the Showground anyone using unreasonable behaviour in their opinion.
7. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES.
8. Please take your litter home with you and DO NOT muck out on the Showground. Please respect the landowner's generosity for the use of their land for your pleasure.
9. Refunds will not be given in any circumstance unless accompanied by a doctors or vets certificate.
10. Prize money is paid on a ratio of 1 prize per 5 competitors.
11. Competitors take part at their own risk.
12. **There will be a £1 per competitor charge payable upon entry towards medical cover.**

No liability will be accepted by the organisers or anyone acting on their behalf for loss, damage, accident or illness to horse, rider, spectator or any other person or property whatsoever.

Health and Safety
